We seek a proactive, dedicated, and experienced event management professional to lead and support the setup and construction team for all Savage Race events. This position will report to the CEO and requires significant collaboration with the Savage Race build crew, vendors, and other members of Savage Race leadership.

Job responsibilities include:

- Lead, manage, and hold accountability for all build crew
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Solicit bids and sourcing of construction equipment and materials
- Establishing written process for all aspects of the position, including all proven means and methods for course construction
- Develop and keep up to date written build plans for each obstacle, including manpower requirements, equipment, parts, and tools list for each
- Coordinate with event manager for equipment rental
- Provide daily written updates via Basecamp software
- Maintain detailed log of hours worked, broken down by obstacle
- Maintain payroll hours
- Coordinate with Obstacle Innovation manager to implement seven new obstacles each year
- Provide detailed project schedules using Microsoft schedule or similar software
- Accountability for all ordering, tracking and delivery of supplies and materials as related to construction
- Accountability for all trailers, and trailer delivery
- Accountability for all inventory and maintenance of construction equipment, tools, and supplies
- Operate equipment in the field as needed



- Help with builds in the field as needed
- Lead construction team meetings
- Must have a valid US driver's license
- Position includes heavy travel during "event season" between February and November
